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The Prudential Approved Societies.

The attached card is intended to be a record of your contributions to National Health and Widows, Orphans and Old Age Contributory Pensions Insurance. It should therefore be carefully preserved by you and produced to the Society's representative whenever a contribution card is surrendered or an application for benefit is made.

A MEDICAL CARD, which will be your evidence of title to medical benefit, will be forwarded from your local Insurance Committee.

Any enquiries about this card should be addressed by you to the Committee and not to the Society. The address of the Insurance Committee can be obtained at your local Post Office.

If you are unemployed, take your Contribution Card, at once, to the Employment Exchange and have it franked for each week you are out of work. This is most important and should be done even though you may not be entitled to unemployment benefit as, for each week you fail to have your card franked whilst unemployed, it may be necessary to pay a week's contribution to entitle you to full benefits.

Members of the Societies can obtain from the Secretary a copy of the Rules on payment of 2d., and a copy of the pamphlet issued by the Ministry of Health summarising the provisions of the National Health Insurance Acts on payment of 2d. Non-members can obtain a copy of the Rules on payment of 3d.

A person ceasing to be compulsorily insurable who wishes to become a Voluntary Contributor for the purposes of either Health or Pensions Insurance or both, should notify the Society at once.

EFFECT OF ARREARS ON HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS.

1. The Health Insurance benefits payable to you during a Benefit Year (which begins on the first Monday in January) depend upon the number of contributions credited to you for the Contribution Year ended in the previous July.
2. If any arrears for a Contribution Year are due from you, your Health Insurance benefits will be reduced or suspended during the next Benefit Year unless you make up the arrears within the period of grace (which runs from the end of the contribution year to the 30th November).
3. Particulars of the arrears due for any contribution year should be notified to you by your Society by means of an Arrears Notice, and the notice will set out the amount of the requisite arrears payment, the manner in which it should be made, and the effect upon your benefits if you pay only part of the arrears.
4. If, for any Contribution Year, arrears are due, but no Arrears Notice has reached you by the 1st October following, you should ask your Society for one.
5. The payment of arrears does not entitle you to receive any benefit after your insurance has ceased.

PENSIONS BENEFITS.

The conditions governing title to contributory pensions will be found in Leaflet O.A.P. 107B (Old Age Pensions) and Leaflet W.P. 6B (Orphans' Pensions). Copies of these Leaflets may be obtained at any Post Office.

Application for old age pension may be made at any time within four months before the applicant's 60th birthday.

TERMINATION OF INSURANCE.

A woman who has ceased to be compulsorily insurable is advised to apply to her Approved Society for Memorandum 247 X which gives information as to the period during which insurance as an employed contributor continues, and the conditions for maintaining insurance as a voluntary contributor.

EFFECT OF ARREARS ON HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS.

- The health insurance benefits payable to you during a Benefit Year (which begins on the first Monday in January) depend upon the number of contributions credited to you for the Contribution Year ending in the previous July.
- If the total of the contributions credited to you for the Contribution Year is 48 or over, you will be entitled to full Health Insurance benefits during the next Benefit Year, provided that you remain in insurance and the qualifying conditions for benefits have been satisfied.
- If, however, the total of your contributions for the Contribution Year is less than 48, your health insurance benefits will be reduced or suspended during the Benefit Year, unless within the period of grace (which runs from the end of the contribution year to the 30th November) you make the appropriate arrears payment.
- Particulars of the arrears due for any contribution year in which your contributions have fallen below 48 should be notified to you by your Society by means of an Arrears Notice, and the Notice will set out the amount of the payment necessary to secure full benefits in the following Benefit Year, the manner in which the payment is to be made, and the effect upon your benefits if part only of the arrears penalty is paid.
- If the contributions credited to you for a contribution year are less than 48, but no Arrears Notice has reached you by the 1st September following, you should ask the Society for one.
- You may not make an arrears payment until you have sent in to your Society cards bearing stamps for all weeks of insurable employment in the contribution year.
- The payment of an arrears penalty does not entitle you to receive any benefit after your insurance has ceased.

PENSION BENEFITS.

Orphans and Old Age Pensions depends in general on the average number of contributions credited in the last three complete contribution years before the claim to pension arises. You cannot, however, pay contributions yourself for weeks of unemployment to make up the average, except as explained in the second paragraph on the back of this card. The payment of an arrears penalty does not affect your benefit under the Pensions Act.

EFFECT OF ARREARS ON HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS.

- The Health Insurance benefits payable to you during a Benefit Year (which begins on the first Monday in January) depend upon the number of contributions credited to you for the Contribution Year ended in the previous July.
- If any arrears for a Contribution Year are due from you, your Health Insurance benefits will be reduced or suspended during the next Benefit Year unless you make up the arrears within the period of grace (which runs from the end of the contribution year to the 30th November).
- Particulars of the arrears due for any contribution year should be notified to you by your Society by means of an Arrears Notice, and the notice will set out the amount of the requisite arrears payment, the manner in which it should be made, and the effect upon your benefits if you pay only part of the arrears.
- If, for any Contribution Year, arrears are due, but no Arrears Notice has reached you by the 1st October following, you should ask your Society for one.
- The payment of arrears does not entitle you to receive any benefit after your insurance has ceased.

PENSIONS BENEFITS.

The conditions governing title to contributory pensions will be found in Leaflet W.P. 6 B. (Widows' and Orphans' Pensions) and Leaflet O.A.P. 107 B. (Old Age Pensions). Copies of these Leaflets may be obtained at any Post Office.

Application for old age pension may be made at any time within four months before the applicant's 65th birthday.

TERMINATION OF INSURANCE.

A person who has ceased to be compulsorily insurable is advised to apply to his Approved Society for Memorandum 247/X which gives information as to the period during which insurance as an employed contributor continues, and the conditions for maintaining insurance as a voluntary contributor.
