in plain and understandable everyday language, avoiding the unnecessary use of unfamiliar specialized terms. No previous acquaintance with either Indian doctrines or Western technical philosophy is required of the reader of this volume. Nor is this all. The entire teaching has been based on an appeal to reason, not to belief, and therefore it has been presented in an ultramodern form throughout, closely linked to science.

These pages throw a flood-light on age-old problems. The comparative usefulness and reliability of faith, intuition, logic and reason as guides in thought and action are clearly dealt with. there is going on a pre-ordained process of physical, emotional, moral and intuitive evolution. In the earlier phase of this planet, man had to build up his ego in order to unfold its capacities. This work has already gone far enough, for it has led to an over-balance of selfishness throughout the world. He had also to learn to use his intellect, which has led to an over-balance of materialism. The presence of wide-spread evil and suffering, especially as they appeared during the world war, is closely connected with his evolution.

It is necessary to awaken the intuition, and to cultivate it, because it is the voice of the soul in man, the Overself, which is the link between him and God. He must now submit to this voice if he is to save himself.

The entire pattern, or "World-Idea," as Brunton calls it, is held in the consciousness of a "World-Mind."
