
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



Dear Dr. Brunton,

I have read most of your books and found them of absorbing interest. I have been practising meditation for about 6 months. As yet I am still in the self inquiry stage and feel in need of help regarding certain aspects.

I shall be most grateful for your comments and advice regarding the following:

- 1. Is there someone in England to whom I could turn to for advice and help?
- 2. I have not yet reached a point of clear acceptance and understanding concerning various aspects:
  - a. What are the relationships between the following?
    - i. The Overself.
    - ii. The Individual Self.
    - iii. The Ego.
    - iv. The Mind.
    - v. The Brain
  - b. Presumably the self-consciousness of a baby is relatively low but this grows to the point of adulthood and, possibly, is less alert or clear with age? How does all this fit in with progressive movement toward joining with the Overself, from a re-incarnation point of view? Is previous progress and karma somehow passed on to the newborn baby in the next life? Does the individual self continue in successive lives or does a new individual self start with each birth but with previous karma and progress somehow built in?
  - c. I have considered deeply the various arguments for there being a separate self entity, i.e. separate from the body. My difficulty is identifying the part that the brain plays.
    - i. In the case of dreams, Is it not arguable that these come from the brain? Perhaps a clarification of 2.a. above will help me.

Dear Brunton:

It is our great pleasure that we can report to you the approaching dawn of that day which has long been awaited by all the members of the ananaikyo as well as by our friends in the United States. We sincerely hope for your hearty support for the realization of this new program we are planning. We have received many kind and hearty letters inviting us to the United States, but until now we have been unable to accept these kind offers due to the lack of an adequate place in your country as a base for our activities.

Through the blessings of God, we now have strong supporters in Mr. & Mrs. Eric Bass who visited our headquarters and sympathized with the activity and devotion of the Founder, Yonosuke Nakano. They have offered us a piece of land in California for our base of work, which is the introduction to the U.S.A. of the traditional and spiritual culture of Japan.

Our new plan is to send at first a few people to investigate and prepare for this purpose, but there are big obstacles in sending them to America aside from government red tape. These obstacles are the regulations on oversea trips by the Foreign Ministry and the exchange controles by the ministry of Finance. To make the long and complicated regulations short, only those who have letters of invitation guaranteeing travel expenses to and from the U.S.A., and also expenses while in the U.S.A., can get approval from the two Ministries. We cannot buy any oversea travel ticket with Japanese currency, but only by dollers send from the U.S.A. Mr. & Mrs. Eric Bass kindly promised us to afford the expenses of our members while in the U.S.A., but there still remains the problem of travel expenses preventing the realization of this long hoped for plan.

In this matter we truly hope for your understanding and support. We hate to impose on your friendship but we can not find any other solutions in this case. If you can afford even a part of the travel expenses of our representatives, please be kind enough to let us know what amount you can afford. That is, we are not asking for a gift, but rather the use of Dollars, in exchange for which we will try to repay you an equal amount in any way we can.

In return for your kind offering we will be happy to do anything within our power. If there is anything you would like to receive from Japan we will purchase and send it to you, or if you or any of your friends are planning to visit Japan we will offer you Japanese money equal to your dollers sent for this plan. Besides these methods of remoneration we are trying to devise other methods in which your money can be returned to you in dollers at a later date.

We, all the members of the Ananaikyo, sincerely hope for your kind and generous support for this program. We will be very obliged, then, if you will let us know the amount of dollars you can help us with. Based on the amount of dollars pledged, we will decide the number of people that can be sent to the United States.

Dear to - Yesterday I went to see Muriel Ames again. This time, I came away humbled by the greatest that lies in this proud lady. It was a humbling revelation for me. She spoke so unselfconsciously and it seemed so obvious what a beautiful wise woman she is and has always been.

She shared with me one particular experience she had just after leaving you - on what she says was perhaps, your last visit to this coast. She was driving away from your abode and suddenly, in a flash, she was granted the vision of eternity-in-all. She said it changed her life. Suddenly she knew we were all in eternity - we had never been out of it! And she told me to, "Ponder upon it." I told her I would - and was quite overcome by her humility in speaking of it.

Oddly, (to me) she had never connected the experience directly with you. And when I said it was a mark of your grace, it caught her by surprise. She said quite honestly, "Do you think so? I had never thought of it like that." But I can see the divine grace behind this: allowing her to think it came of itself thru her own direct perception. It has sustained her all these yearsover ten, she thought. When I mentioned this was grace, she seemed surprised by that too.

Well, I was overcome at the beauty of that visit. She unwrapped her bible and between the loose and worn pages she had placed, "my life." She shared with me some letters that Pers Chardin had written to her and they expressed the beauty she had brought into his life by her love and faith. This must be the same Chardin that Aileen Coates spoke of hin her letter to you. I was astonished to hear more about this great Catholic priest (amongst other things) One thing I remember she read aloud was: "Rome does not like me very much - but I shall win them over!" And I understand, he did. There were many other inspiring tender things and he spoke about his project (the Peking-man?) and it was most beautiful to hear. But Muriel says all these letters and those she has from you, also, will be buried with her. They will never be released. That is all she is asking be buried with her - her Bible with all her per-sonal cherished memories. Many poems and tributes to her mother and grandmother lie amongst her beloved Priest and other spiritual written memories. She spoke of two passages in the Bible that meant most to her: I can only call to mind one now, but will ask again for the other -(however, I would remember it if I heard it). "Unless Ye be born again - ye cannot enter the Kingdom of Heaven." I hope that is right. She has no fear (never has had) of transition but has a prayer that her cat, "Miss Otis" will preced her in death - otherwise it will be put to sleep immediately. I wondered, as she talked and beautiful things unfolded if she was preparing for this "transition" or simply content when it came. But she did say she hoped it would be "In my own bed and dignified." hollow - or is it "hallowed" inside.

But when he was writing, from the fallen eye-lids of the Master arose like powerful holophotes of white shining lights, seeing-me, the eyes of the Adept: "Para en querido Jorge, a quem el carinho de Ra Mak Hotep ha conduzido hasta la AMO para que reanudes sus antiguos lazos con el Rito Egipcio de Osisis. Amenhorat." And he drew the symbol of Venus beside his signature, inside a triangle with its point to the top. To your aquitance, "AMO" was the name of our school: Occidental Mystic Association.

Since this time, the occurences of my life b began to intensify, conducting me to a way of life that has became my intimate life, what is over all things the world can give me. Always going along with the Master and trying to follow him the best I could, until he left his carnal cover in November, 6th, 1970, when he gave me his last bless. Before this he had already passed me the knowledgements I was able to assimilate and also the succession of this same line: Sarva Yoga, that he had founded. But also the more possible about the occidental line, as Martinism and Esoteric Christianism of the lile of Master Philippe of Lyon, so much so I don't concive these two lines separately, except as form.




