Readers' Letters 15

Editor's Note: The Readers' Letters files consist of correspondence between PB and his students, followers, fellow philosophers, spiritual leaders, friends and family. Most of these letters were sent to PB by readers of his books. They are in no particular order, and there may be letters by the same person in other files as well. Most of the letters in this file were written between 1929 and 1975.

PB had a tendency to make edits, write notes regarding his replies, or insert address information and meeting times on the letters themselves after receipt. We have noted PB's insertions and marginalia, but have not noted edits made by the original author, assuming that they were corrections made at the same time as the rest of the letter. To preserve both readability and the voice of the author, we have corrected spelling errors but have generally left grammar as is.

Less interesting letters have been summarized instead of fully transcribed. Please refer to the scanned PDFs for the full content, or to view all stationary headers, postmarks, unidentified markings, marginalia, etc. Proper names and dates have been written exactly as found in the original for each letter in this file; where we discovered multiple versions of a person's name, we have noted the full name either in the body of the text in {curly brackets} or in a footnote.

In many letters, there are words that are illegible or missing; in such cases we have included either our best guess or the word "illegible" inside {curly brackets}. In rare circumstances, we have added a word or phrase to a letter for readability, which are also noted with {curly brackets}; a footnote was added where we deemed it helpful. – Timothy Smith (TJS), 2020

Dear Dr Brunton,

I have just finished reading your wonderful book "The Inner Reality" - simple and easily understood and sincere, I enjoyed it very much and thank you for it. I have been wondering if I could ask you for some advice? About forty (40) years ago and thought - to be at death's door, I had a vision, in full (awake) consciousness, of the Lord Jesus Christ and on either side of him a figure, all were composed of soft yet radiant Light. I was not able to think but was spellbound, as it were. All this happened after months of worry about an illness I suffered and torment as to whether there was God etc. Since this I have looked and studied various sects etc. etc. ("A voice told me to 'Look first the Kingdom of Heaven' - and this was the reason for my search) however³ I have not been happy with any of the organizations – the latest being "The Infinite Way" by Joel S. Dear PB

Yesterday I went to see Muriel Ames again. This time, I came away humbled by the greatest that lies in this proud lady. It was a humbling revelation for me. She spoke so unselfconsciously and it seemed so obvious what a beautiful wise woman she is and has always been.

She shared with me one particular experience she had just after leaving you – on what she says was perhaps, you last visit to this coast. She was driving away from your abode and suddenly, in a flash, she was granted the vision of eternity-in-all. She said it changed her life. Suddenly she <u>knew</u> we were all in eternity – we had never been out of it! And she told me to, "Ponder upon it." I told her I would – and was quite overcome by her humility in speaking of it.¹⁸

Oddly, (to me) she had never connected the experience directly with you. And when I said it was a mark of your grace, it caught her by surprise. She said quite honestly, "Do you think so? I had never thought of it like that." But I can see the divine grace behind this: allowing her to think it came of itself through her own direct perception. It has sustained her all these years – over ten, she thought. When I mentioned this was grace, she seemed surprised by that too.

Well, I was overcome at the beauty of that visit. She unwrapped her bible and between the loose and worn pages she had placed, "my life." She shared with me some letters that Pere Chardin had written to her and they expressed the beauty she had brought into his life by her love and faith. This must be the same Chardin that Aileen Coates spoke of in her letter to you. I was astonished to hear more about this great

Catholic priest – (amongst other things) One thing I remember she read aloud was: "Rome does not like me very much – but I shall win them over!" And I understand, he did. There were many other inspiring tender things and he spoke about his project (the Peking-man?) and it was most beautiful to hear. But Muriel says all these letters and those she has from you, also, will be buried with her. They will never be released. That is all personal cherished memories. Many poems and tributes to her mother and grandmother lie amongst her beloved Priest and other spiritual written memories. She spoke of two passages in the Bible that meant most to her: I can only call to mind one now, but will ask again for the other – (however, I would remember it if I heard it). "Unless Ye be born again – ye cannot enter the Kingdom of Heaven." I hope that is right. She has no fear (never has had) of transition but has a prayer that her cat, "Miss Otis" will precede her in death – otherwise it will be put to sleep immediately. I wondered, as she talked and beautiful things unfolded if she was preparing for this "transition" or simply content when it came. But she did say she hoped it would be "In my own bed and dignified." I left her hollow – of is it "hallowed" inside.

This would not be Muriel unless she told in her own "unpredictable and inimitable way" a story: God was very tired; He was exhausted. So he got on the phone and made a call to Christ. He said "Get up here – I want to see you." So Christ hurried up and God said: "See here – I'm very very tired and I'm going to take a vacation and you are to take over and run things." Christ was astonished. He said "you're going away?" And God said, "Yes, I'm exhausted and you are to take over." Whereupon Christ said, "What! And leave me all alone up here with that Ghost!!"

At¹⁹ one point I looked at her bedside table where she has your picture. And it seemed to have a fresco-like glow.

Upon two walls were, in beautiful simple frames, Altar cloths. I recognized in the center of one, the fluttering wings and image of a moth type butterfly – around the edges were flowers and dainty leaves. Upon the other, directly over her bed, was a symbolic Cross but not the standard Westernized one. Both of these Altar pieces spoke of her past connections (it seemed to me) with the Church and when PB was in it. I was again astonished as I had never connected her with you like this before. But when I think upon it, <u>all</u> who have contacted you most certainly must have been in the Church – my Mother, sisters and many more – all of us! The "Church" seems embedded in our Soul. It is all very poignant – and Yet I understand very little if anything at all.

I²⁰ do not know if I shall see Muriel again – and yet, my heart must not cry, but accept as courageously and blithely as her own – but if I can, I will re-route myself through Aspen upon my return journey West and visit her and "Toots" Fluttering above her shoulder like a symbol, direct center in the Altar cloth.



My husband both wish you well and know that the world is a better place for you having been here.



I quoted to her excerpts from your book "The Quest Of The Overself" and she suggested that I ask <u>you</u> for clarification as she felt unable to do so to my satisfaction. If you lack the time or inclination to appease my curiosity I will understand perfectly.

Page 230 - "The divine atom of the Overself is situated in the right ventricle of the heart, etc."

Question: Man #1 dies from brain damage or other causes and his heart is transplanted into the body of man #2. Does the divine atom withdraw, or is it transplanted along with the physical heart? The heart form man #2 is removed and discarded. Does the divine atom withdraw into the universal life current and be replaced by the atom from man #1? Or does it hover about and re-enter the new heart?

Page⁴¹ 231 - "The real seat of human consciousness is not in the brain but in the heart."

Question: If a man's brain damaged beyond repair and the heart is kept pumping by artificial means, does the ego "formed from that minute fragment of transcendental vital force and greater consciousness" (page 232) just disappear, or does it re-descend to the divine atom in the heart? Is sexual connection to be completely avoided? If not, what is the interval allowed, taking into account the health aspect also.



My world has changed considerably. I am very happy and delighted with Life. Of course I was always of a happy nature, but today my happiness is a mature, grownup happiness; at least it is sufficient unto me. What else can I ask for? As I am happy, it will spread and that too is a happy thought!

As always, I thank you for your assistance to my happiness and may I return it a hundredfold and many times over!

My life, as usual remains busy, but then I like it that way. I have my pen friends and those in person. It is so wonderful to feel of help, and every time I bear witness to another's happiness, it is my own.

Have you read the books written by Neville? He uses just the one name. He lives and teaches in New York City, although I believe his classes are private. His⁴⁹ books have also meant a great deal to me. If you haven't read them I should like to send them on to you as they are not even as large as the conventional size. I think you would like them. They have revolutionized my life. There are six of them and most of them can be read in an hour or so. His writing is based upon the bible, but his interpretations are far removed from orthodox Christianity.

Le Gros continues with astrological lectures (he is the one you heard downtown) but I never hear him nor do I see any longer those with whom I studied while I was interested in the subject.

And the more I consciously realized that we are what we believe the time came when I found no usefulness whatsoever from the subject and dropped it completely giving all of my books to those who wanted them. The main reason I have for concluding astrology cannot be used as a "safe" guide is this: Astrology has no way of determining the person or how evolved he or she is who is represented by a particular chart. In other words, we cannot look at a chart and say that this is a person of Super-Intelligence and Understanding - we simply do not know! And there is no way of knowing, if there is, I haven't found it yet, and believe me, I looked mighty hard!

Secondly, with the above information lacking - how can we possibly judge the natal aspects and those formed by transit and progression? Absolutely impossible! I saw (if it was correct) the⁵³ chart of a mongoloid idiot with three trines to Mercury!!

Thirdly, and perhaps most important of all - and as you have stated also, - it is possible to alter our karma, - the "grace" of God, another factor, - how can we safely conclude that certain aspects produce certain results. There is no way for any astrologer to determine with any accuracy just what I shall doo with my life - or what, at this point, I am capable of doing (though I'm not limiting the Infinite) or shall do!

Astrologers claim great things for astrology, and I heard much of this at the convention in Cleveland in June, '52; however, after due consideration I realized that many of them were living lives of subjugation - that because they were living by certain

207 - 212 Letter from Sarvananda (Georg Kritikos) Belo Horizonte 3th, January, 1974

Mr Paul Brunton App. 11, Bloc A Chemin de Ballalaz 14 CH 1820-Montreux (Vaud) Swiss

Dear Mr Brunton,

Not long ago, my friend Carlos Alberto Pinto Fonseca visited you and came back with "a new wind" to Brazil, bringing something palpable clear from the few hours he was allowed too be with you. To me, myself, that contact and my friend's posterior report were reinforcement and balsam. What happens is that you don't know me, but I've known you for many years. To put you closer to the fact, I've got to tell you that it was your book "Secret Egypt," the first spiritual type I've read, and it was also, a sudden gap to the past, my past and tie with Egypt, and then with India. It was in Uruguay, 1948 or 1949, when I lost the protection of my family that wanted me to be in a golden cage, after having spent the last months of the war in front of the North Sea, I fell in a deep depression, because of the emptiness I felt under my feet. Despaired, seeking help, your book cheered me up, but I came down again for finding out that I had a mirror in front of me, the experience of somebody else. In 1950, I was put in the way of my Master, Swami Sevananda (Viscount Leo A. de Mascheville) who started me later in his trailer. Reading your book I experienced a strong impression with the Egyptian Adept, and one night I woke up suddenly, in other words I was awaken to see a really fireworks pouring from my Ajna-Chakra with a very intense silver light that had a quick crackly, among an intense and extraordinary vibration or presence dominating all the environment (surrounding.) After this my third eye began to work.

Later I was informed that it was the Adept himself who had made all this, and also that it was him who saved me in a day-break when I was in a sea-battle during the war in 1945. However I never took a fire-arm except for shooting at a target.

Even the initiation that occurred in March, 1951, about what I've said you before was made in fact, by the Egypt Adept himself. I was then a disciple of Master Sevananda, who oughtn't be unknown to you, since I know he was in contact with you through the mail. It was a full moon in beginning of 1952, I was visiting him in his trailer, on the Park del Plata, near Montevideo, as I did every weekend. We were chattering, sitting down surrounded by a pleasant Indian incense, when suddenly appeared the powerful presence of the Adept. I had asked someone to make copies of the photograph of his eyes and given them to the Master. The atmosphere became so intensely impressioned by the presence of the Adept that the tears began⁶⁵ to drip down

from my eyes, while the Adept, superposed on Master Sevananda, was writing a dedication to me in one of the portraits I had brought. But when he was writing, from the fallen eye-lids of the Master arose like powerful holophotes of white shining lights, seeing-me, the eyes of the Adept: "Para el querido Jorge, a quem el carinho de Ra Mak Hotep ha conduzido hasta la <u>AMO</u> para que reanudes sus antiguos lazos con el Rito Egipcio de Osiris. Amenhorat." And he drew the symbol of Venus beside his signature, inside a triangle with its point to the top. To your acquaintance, "AMO" was the name of our school: Occidental Mystic Association.

Since this time, the occurrences of my life began to intensify, conducting me to a way of life that has become my intimate life, what is over all things the world can give me. Always going along with the Master and trying to follow him the best I could, until he left his carnal cover in November, 6th, 1970, when he gave me his last bless. Before this he had already passed me the knowledgements I was able to assimilate and also the succession of this same line: Sarva Yoga, that he had founded. But also the more possible about the occidental line, as Martinism and Esoteric Christianism of the like of Master Philippe of Lyon, so much so I don't conceive these two lines separately, except as form.

I have understood and felt deeply when you said to my friend Carlos Alberto, that we must join East and West. I have worked in this sense trying to make understand whom wants to know it.

Forgive me, Mr Brunton, my chatter and my talking about myself. In fact I feel honored and happy by telling you these things, because I don't say to much when I affirm that you are a symbol for me, a focus of light, the person who saw and talked face to face with the Egyptian Adept, whom I feel like a father and a great protector, and whose face and eyes he shows principally to my wife, so much so wishing to be allowed too see him physically some day I felt a little disappointed in my ignorance when I knew, by Carlos Alberto, that he had died. His presence is frequent and strong in the meditation nights, of our mystic group on every Wednesday.

By the other had I write you because Carlos Alberto told me that you wanted to have three portraits: One of Maitre Philippe, other of Master Sevananda and another of mine: So I send you them.

My English isn't good and I write to you with the help of a friend I intend to improve my English in order to have not difficulties of communication in India, where I intend to be between January 10th, and March of this year, to improve my Method of Yoga therapy, and also try to find saint persons, to open a little more my internal way. I beg your pardon if this kind of expression seems to you a little ingenuous but I believe you will understand me if I say you that my thirst is great. For this reason I believe also that I will be guided. If it won't be so much I ask you please to give me some advice and indications from your experience. Without pretentions I want to use all that would be possible, taking into account my imperfection to serve inside the way received from my Master, since the phisic-moral till the psychic-spiritual⁶⁶ Could you let me, when I come back from India, to go till Montreux and great you?

I ask you, if you remember to include my name in your prayers. My heart, grateful by the help you gave me through your writings, will always ask for your spiritual happy.
